

Distance Learning: Advanced Higher English 2020-21

Between April 20th and June 19th, students who have chosen Advanced Higher English will work on a range of skills and activities, creating Portfolio pieces which will be externally marked and building skills for the final exam. The working week will focus on the following areas:

What will I be studying?	What does this involve?
Dissertation	Pupils will begin to choose multiple linked texts for their externally marked Dissertation, conducting preliminary research, note-making and liaising with staff around choices. This is the beginning of a process which will continue until April 2021.
Portfolio	Pupils will work on at least one creative writing piece as part of their externally marked Portfolio. Pupils will receive feedback on a first draft and complete a second, final draft for the end of term.
Textual Analysis	Pupils will begin to work on the Textual Analysis component of the final exam, building competence by writing structured essays on new texts which show understanding, analysis and evaluation skills. Pupils will continue to practice this skill until the exam in May 2021.

Accessing the online resources and completing the initial coursework does not guarantee participation in the course in the new academic year – this will be dependent on SQA certification.
